We will aggressively pursue all state and federal guidelines for removing the geese from the lake. Lakefront homeowners are asked to chase the geese off their properties as well. Putting up netting along your waterfront will greatly help deter them from the property.

Rules and Reminders

- Seneca Lake is a private lake reserved for the use of only the owners/renters in good standing and their guests. The garage and bathrooms are locked. Contact us if you do not have the code. Please lock up before leaving.
- The garage must be opened before participating in beach activities including, but not limited to, swimming and boating. State regulations require that there be access to an emergency phone and rescue materials.

 No one under the age of 16 is to use the beach without an adult.
 No one is to swim alone.



- All boats need to be registered with the beach club in order to be stored on-site.
 Contact us for a registration form.
 Please do not use other owner's boats.
 All boats are marked. Seneca Lake provides a canoe, row boat, and paddle boat for your enjoyment. Please be sure it is marked with SLC before using it.
 Boats must enter the water from the left of the dock. All boats must be returned to the rack and stored upside down to eliminate any safety hazards from standing water.
- Fishing is catch and release. Please do not fish inside swimming area. Please clean up any extra lines, hooks, or supplies. We don't want any accidents.
- Parking at the beach is limited to those using the beach and their guests. There is no overnight parking allowed.
