Seneca Lake Club – Boat Storage Agreement

Boat storage in the Seneca Lake Club boat racks is provided as a convenience to members who register their boats annually with the Club. By registering a boat and signing this form, the boat owner acknowledges and agrees to the following:

1. **Assumption of Risk** - The boat owner assumes all risks associated with storing a boat on Club property, including but not limited to damage caused by weather, acts of nature, falling objects, equipment failure, or the actions of other individuals.
2. **No Responsibility for Damage or Theft** - The Seneca Lake Club, including its officers, board members, volunteers, and agents, shall not be responsible or liable for any damage to, loss of, or theft of any boat, motor, trailer, accessories, or other personal property stored in or around the boat storage racks.
3. **Unauthorized Use** - The Seneca Lake Club is not responsible for any unauthorized use, operation, or movement of a stored boat by other individuals. The boat owner is solely responsible for securing their boat and any associated equipment.
4. **Compliance with Club Rules** - The boat owner agrees to abide by all Seneca Lake Club rules and regulations governing boating, fishing, and watercraft use on Seneca Lake. These rules may be amended from time to time by the Club. Current rules and regulations are available on the Club's website at www.senecalakeclub.org.
5. **Boat Identification and Registration Sticker** - Upon registration and receipt of payment, the Club will send the current year Seneca Lake Club boat registration sticker. The sticker must be affixed to each registered boat in a visible location while the boat is stored on Club property.
6. **Club Authority to Move or Remove Boats** - The Club reserves the right to move, relocate, or remove any boat that is improperly stored, unregistered, creates a safety concern, violates Club rules, or if access or maintenance requires it. The Club shall not be responsible for damage resulting from such movement.
7. **Abandoned Boats** - Any boat stored in the racks that is not registered, has not paid the annual fee by June 1, does not display a current sticker, or remains after membership has lapsed may be considered abandoned. The Club will make reasonable efforts to contact the owner. If the boat is not claimed or removed within a reasonable period, the Club may remove and dispose of the boat as it is deemed appropriate. Any associated costs may be the responsibility of the boat owner.
8. **Indemnification** - The boat owner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Seneca Lake Club, its officers, board members, volunteers, and agents from any claims or liabilities arising out of the storage or use of the boat while on Club property.

Fishing and Watercraft/Boating Rules

Fishing

- **Seneca Lake is a catch and release lake. All fish caught must be released back into the lake and unharmed**
- **Fishing is prohibited within the roped off areas of the beach**
- **Ice Fishing is prohibited at all times**

Boats/Watercraft

- **Gas powered watercraft/boats are prohibited**
- **All watercraft/boats must be registered and marked for identification**
- **Watercraft/Boats are to be launched only from the left side of the dock**
- **Watercraft/boats may not be docked on the beach**
- **Personal floatation devices are required for each boater**
